## HIGHWAY SUPERINTENDENT REPORT

Water - Samples and readings acquired, Flushed where needed. Installed MXU's on water district #9, sanitary survey completed with Orleans County Health Dept., 2 people went to water class in Carlton. Shared services with the Towns of Albion, Elba, Ridgeway, Shelby, Clarendon, Murray, Villages of Albion and Holley and the Orleans County public works. Sign repairs completed as needed, mowing roadsides completed. Hot patching. Buildings - Oil/water separator serviced, setting up trucks for winter, 10 wheelers - all passed inspections, equipment repairs completed, picked up 20 concrete barriers for support of old salt barn.

#### ASSESSOR'S REPORT

The Assessor submitted a report outlining the calculation of the 2021 Equalization Rate from the New York State Department of Taxation and Finance. There have been 8 home sales in the Town of Barre since March. The combined 2020 assessed value of those homes was \$673,900. The combined sales price of those homes was \$853,800. The average of 26.69% above assessed value.

Whereas, the Town of Barre developed the budget for the Water District
No.9 project based as estimate for the cost for the Net Interest
Expense, and Whereas, the actual cost for interest on the Bond

in the budget line for the Net Interest Expense (from \$4,665 to
\$10,500), with a corresponding reduction in the Contingency. Tom
